The Challenge

The client required an IT environment capable of continuing full operations even during internet or broader infrastructure outages. In an assisted living and hospice setting, the nursing team must be able to always perform critical functions, including during system disruptions:



Access resident health records and medication administration system



Administer and document medications without delay or manual workaround



Print critical care documentation and compliance records



Communicate internally across the facility via phone systems

Unlike a corporate office environment, “waiting for systems to come back online” is not an option for a care team. In an assisted living or hospice facility, a downed system at the wrong moment can delay medication administration, interrupt care documentation, or sever communication between clinical staff during a critical incident.

Layered on top of this operational challenge is a stringent regulatory environment. The client operates under both HIPAA and HITECH compliance requirements, which include annual audits, data security obligations, and strict standards governing how health information is stored, accessed, and transmitted. Any IT partner must not only meet these standards but actively maintain and demonstrate readiness for them throughout the year.

This is a distinct discipline from traditional disaster recovery: rather than routing everything to a secondary data center when the primary fails, the fail-down architecture ensures that even if all external connections are severed, the facility continues to function.

Nurses can still log into workstations and access clinical systems



Medication administration systems remain fully operational



Health record data required for care continues to function locally



Critical documentation and printing workflows remain available



Internal phone systems continue operating within the facility

This architecture allows the client's care teams to continue delivering safe, uninterrupted care under any network or infrastructure conditions. By keeping the most clinically critical functions local and resilient, Maintech has eliminated the risk of a connectivity failure translating into a care failure.

HIPAA and HITECH Compliance Management

Operating in healthcare requires more than technical competence. It requires a deep understanding of the regulatory landscape and a proactive approach to staying ahead of audit requirements. Maintech maintains a Business Associate Agreement (BAA) with the client, a formal HIPAA requirement for any vendor with access to protected health information.
